## What is the development in Europe on the national level?

In many nations, people started to work for the formation of a *National CHARIS Service of Communion*. The European members of the *International Service of Communion* of CHARIS, Etienne Mellot and Paolo Maino are available to help. They have written a letter to all the (former) national contacts in Europe with a survey the get an overview of the situation. Answers are coming in. The *International Service of Communion* provided recently guidelines for the national

level, including very helpful definitions of 'The Catholic Charismatic Renewal', 'Baptism in the Holy Spirit', 'Realities or expressions', 'Prayer Groups', 'National Network of prayer groups', 'Communities' and 'A ministry'.

## What is the development on the European level?

Etienne an Paolo have created an ad interim European Co-ordinating Team, to prepare a first meeting of the European CHARIS Continental Service of Communion next year. The composition of the European Service of Communion is given by the statutes: Each Continental Service of Communion is composed of:

- 1.- one representative from each National Service of Communion;
- 2.- one representative from each Network of communities present in the region;
- 3.- one representative of each International network of evangelization schools present on the region; 4.- two representatives from specific ministries in the continent; and
- 5.- two Catholics under 30 years old. If you think you are in one of these categories and you want to know more about it, please feel free to contact us. Like the statues say about the national level: 'be as inclusive as possible and open to new and emerging realities. The model focuses on communion rather than government or structure.'
