

In this issue: **Who is Christof Hemberger,**  
the new young member of the European sub-committee of ICCRS ?

Christof Hemberger, was elected by the young people of CCR-Europe, to be member of the European sub-committee of ICCRS (See Eucril 107). And he is involved in the preparations for the World Youth Days in Cologne, August 2005. We asked him to present himself.

**Christof Hemberger:**

"Age: 30, married to Sabine Hemberger since 2 years. My wife is a midwife at a local hospital.

Coming from a "normal catholic bavarian" family I got to know the Charismatic Renewal in 1985 as a participant on a youth camp held in our hometown. Since then I was part of prayergroups, later on of the Jedidja-community in my hometown Wuerzburg.

In the early 90th I was involved in building up the youth ministry of the community. 1997 I was called by the NSC to be part of the national leadership team of the national CCR youth ministry.

I studied "Socialwork" at the Wuerzburg-University. First I was working in a home for handicapped children, then in a governmental youth office. 1999 I was asked by the NSC to work for the CCR in Germany fulltime.

My main responsibilities are: Building up a network between the regional youth-ministries in Germany, supporting leaders in their projects (like youth-retreats, camps, seminars...), running the office of the national youth ministry and being responsible for national staff- and leadership training (youth) as well as for our annual summer camps for Teenagers (600 participants).

Besides this it is my task to support the CCR at projects like the national conference and to be representative of the youth ministry in the NSC."
