Today in Europe, however, Christians find themselves increasingly out of step with the cultural narrative, marginalised in the media, and sometimes in conflict with their own governments. It is very tempting for us in the Christian community to retreat behind the safety of our church walls to avoid losing more ground to the growing influence of secularism. Could it be that God is actually calling us instead to a more radical course of action, one that is more similar to the Acts of the Apostles than to the church of the last century? What is this "missionary option" that Pope Francis referred to? What would it look like in our parishes, our communities, our youth groups and our families?”

These are **the topics** of the next RELaY-Conference taking place from 4<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> of May 2016 in Kaunas, Lithuania.
