Many of you are planning their trips to Rome already in order to attend the Great Jubilee of 50 years of Charismatic Renewal in the Catholic Church. We are expecting participants from all over the world. Many nations and communities have already started with their preparations to get their people to Rome at Pentecost 2017.

Program in Rome

At www.ccrgoldenjubilee2017.org you now can register online – the technicians are working hard to get the registration system working as soon as possible in other languages.

The program will be very colorful and interesting for many. We will have a youth festival, special gatherings for theologians, charismatic communities, schools of Evangelization, an ecumenical forum – plus opportunities to gather for praise and worship, adoration and evangelization in various places in Rome. There will also be a series of workshops on various CCR topics offered. This decision follows Pope Francis' personal suggestion to establish, in faith, a minimum fee for this occasion - giving the opportunity for many to possibly take part in this event - trusting that every participant would be an advocate for this unique CCR Jubilee and will have the chance to be providentially generous, adding his/her own donation in the online registration form.
