Call To Prophetic Intercession

From 2nd till 7th of October 2018 an ICCRS-Intercession-Course (ITC) will be held in Fulda, Germany. This ITC has taken place already all over the world but not in Europe.

The CCR in Germany is very happy to be able to invite participants to his country to experience this wonderful seminar! This ITC will be run *in English and German only*. If one would like to have translation into another language, he/she will need to bring along (and pay for) an own translator. The space is limited, quick registration recommend.

What is an intercession training course?

The course is aimed at Catholics already involved in intercession and for those who may sense a calling to intercession. It will also be a great help for those who are new to this type of prayer.

Activity

Teachings on various aspects of intercession, prophetic intercession, workshops and sharing, intercession outreach, Eucharistic celebrations, Eucharistic adoration, praise and worship, fellowship.
