

In this issue: *Report European Catholic Charismatic Renewal-Leaders' Summit in Germany.*

From 8th till 10th of March the *European Subcommittee of ICCRS (ESCI)* invited all national CCR-leaders and leaders of major CCR-community-networks to come to Heiligenbrunn, Germany.

For the last time ESCI held this meeting as with Pentecost 2019 ICCRS and its subcommittees will cease and CHARIS will be in charge for the international and continental service to the worldwide CCR.

60 leaders from more than 20 european nations followed the invitation and came to this meeting in Germany. Among them three of the newly appointed members of the *International Service of Communion* of CHARIS were present: continental representatives for Europe Paolo Maini (Italy) and Etienne Mellot (France); and Jean-Luc Moens (Belgium), who will function as first moderator of CHARIS (www.charis.international).

Preparation of CHARIS

As one of those entrusted by Pope Francis with the preparations for CHARIS to become alive, Michelle Moran explained again “the way to CHARIS” and gave an update about the present situation.

Vision of Pope Francis

In a second session, underlined with video-sequences of Pope Francis' speeches to the CCR in the last years (www.iccrs.tv*), Michelle helped us to understand the vision of our present pope for the CCR and her call in today's world.

Francis' encouragements and appeals given during the last years touched many of the present leaders. The question: “How do we live what the Pope expects from us today?” was raised and discussed in small groups.

The new moderator

Jean-Luc Moens shared his vision about CHARIS, and he explained the present situation: CHARIS will come into service from Pentecost 2019 onwards. Up till then there are many things to be done and still to be decided. In a time of “questions and answers” many national leaders took the opportunity to get a clearer understanding of the developments of CHARIS.

Ongoing formation

Christof Hemberger explained the formation programmes ICCRS was running during the last year and gave an overview about the upcoming formation courses that ICCRS/CHARIS are running in the near future (www.iccrs.org/en/formation-project/).

During one of the Eucharists all present leaders gathered around the members of the *International Service of Communion* of CHARIS, interceding and praying for them.

Last meeting ESCI



As this meeting was the last one that ESCI organised, Christof Hemberger as the chairman of ESCI, thanked all present members of ESCI for their work and their support to the European CCR.
