

Short English information on CCR in Romania

In Romania there are two networks of Catholic charismatic renewal: a Romanian speaking network of two charismatic communities (contact Agneza Timpu) and a Hungarian speaking network of prayergroups and youthministry led by the *Transylvania service committee*.

In general: The *Hungarian speaking* part is in Transylvania, in central Romania. And the rest of the country is Romanian speaking, situated all around Transylvania, ie: North, East, South, West.

The two charismatic communities in the *Romanian speaking part* are: the Community Emanuel in Bucharest, I: www.reinnoirea-carismatica.ro; and the Community Magnificat in 5 cities: Bucharest - South, Popesti-Leordeni - South (close to Buchares) , Ramnicu-Valcea: South-West (Northwest from Bucharest), Bacau: East (East-Romania, not for from Moldova), Alba-Iulia - Center (central Romania), I: www.comunitateamagnificat.ro

In Transylvania are also some bilingual communities and two Romanian speaking communities which belong to the network of the Transylvania service committee. Website: www.ekkm.ro and www.keresztirany.ro
