

CHARIS EUROPEAN SERVICE OF COMMUNION



In this issue: CHARIS in the continental European synodal process and a review of the online formation program of CHARIS



Last September we received a strong encouragement from the Dicastery in Rome to live the synodal way and to offer formation for it (see **EU-CHARIS-Info-letter No 6**). The responsibility of every member of the Church, as was stressed so strongly by Vatican II, is coming more and more into practice in this way. Continental meetings have been a part of the synod. For Europe, this meeting was in Prague, last February, and Cathy Brenti from France represented CHARIS in this European Assembly of the Synod. What did she experience in Prague?



On February 9th, the European Assembly of the Synod came to a close in Prague. All the Episcopal Conferences of Europe were gathered for this Assembly, and we were about 200 participants. There were 39 delegations from the Episcopal Conferences of Europe, each of 3 or 4 persons, which is to say about 130 persons, among which about 40 bishops, plus 30 "guests" of which I was part on behalf of CHARIS.

It was an impressive and very rich Church experience. The basis for reflection was of course the Continental Stage Document (DEC): Enlarge the space of your tent. It emphasizes above all:

Listening, as openness to welcome, in a desire for inclusion and communion; Mission, and dialogue, with believers of other religions; Commitment and Participation; Structures and institutions to live communion, participation and mission; Liturgy.

VERY RICH AND VARIED TOPICS

We had some interventions from the cardinals present: H. Em. Mario Grech, Secretary of the Synod, JC Hollerich, from Luxembourg, Rapporteur of the Synod, and Marc Ouellet, former Prefect of the Dicastery for Bishops. And above all, each delegation had six minutes to speak. The topics were very rich and varied: reform of governance, co-responsibility of the laity, welcoming homosexuals, integration of remarried divorcees, concern for the peripheries, participation of women in decision-making bodies, ordination of married men, involvement of young people, etc.

Each morning, there were times of meeting in small working groups (of 10-12 people), thought out according to the method of "spiritual conversation", allowing everyone to express themselves. This was very interesting, given the differences of opinion.



CLOSE TO WHAT IS RENEWAL

We had a very good contact with Archbishop Gintaras Grušas, Archbishop of Vilnius, Lithuania and President of the Council of European Episcopal Conferences, who is very close to everything that is "Renewal".

The Latin liturgy has no more secrets for us since everything was celebrated in this language. We had a mass in the cathedral of Prague, magnificent, as well as in the monastery of the Premonstratensians, idem. The temperature being "interesting", -8°C, we experienced two hours of celebrations in the cold every time, unforgettable!

We believe that the reception of the Holy Spirit, lived in the experience of the Baptism in the Spirit, leads to a personal encounter with Christ, which opens the heart to listening to the Word of God, to listening to others, to what the Holy Spirit can say through each one to advance and build the Church, in a spirit of humility and repentance.

DOCILITY TO THE HOLY SPIRIT

We are pleased with the place given to listening in the synodal process and to docility to the Holy Spirit in resolving tensions.

It is thanks to this listening that the charisms of each member of the Church can be discerned, and that each one can be given his or her place, not all being called to fulfil the same functions, as in the image of the body we can find in Saint Paul. But each one being at the service of his brother, and of the building up of the whole Church in a spirit of charity."


